FORMAT:

In addition to the incredible live acts we know and love, we're also offering a Silent Showcase to display our Tigers' talents that may not be conducive to a performance - because talent comes in all shapes and sizes! The Talent Show will encompass both Live Performances and the Silent Showcase at an all-school assembly and evening event for families to attend. They're sure to be Out of This World!

AVAILABLE CATEGORIES FOR STUDENTS:

4th and 5th-Grade Emcees – announcing acts, managing timing and performances – these are speaking roles for both the assembly and evening performances. Priority given to 5th-graders. See details below.

Live Performance – Singing, playing an instrument, dancing, monologues, routines – anything able to be performed for a crowd.

Silent Showcase – Submit a photo of your Tiger in action or of a project they are proud to show off - artwork, screenshots of video game levels they've either created or beat, etc. Or submit any flat paper product (picture, paintings, sketches) which can be hung and displayed. For any object (sculptures/built items no larger than 2'x2') please email Rachel so we can determine how we can accommodate.

Baked Goods – The Showcase also includes a baked goods portion! Show off your culinary skills! Full recipe cards will need to be turned in by March 4th to participate. Culinary works of art will be displayed next to the recipe card, but not available for tasting.

IMPORTANT DATES:

- Permission slips for all performing participants due Friday February 8th
- Auditions (performances only) Wednesday February 28th and Thursday February 29th,
 3:50pm 5pm
- Showcase and recipe submissions (pictures or artwork, baked goods recipes) due
 Monday March 4th.
- Workshops (performances only) Wednesday March 6th, Thursday March 7th, 3:50pm 5pm (if we have too many slots, we will extend the time to 6pm both days)
- <u>Dress Rehearsal</u> (performance only and mandatory) Thursday March 14th 3:50-5
- Talent Show all-school assembly: Friday, March 15th at 10am
- Talent Show for families: Friday, March 15th 6pm 9pm

LIVE PERFORMANCE RULES

- 1. **Completed permission forms** must be signed by a parent/guardian and returned to the school office by February 8th in order for students to secure an audition time. Each student in a group act needs a separate permission form, and forms for each group member must be submitted and stapled together. Parents will be notified prior to the audition date of their student's scheduled audition time.
- 2. **Students are only allowed to perform once**. If a student is in a group act, student may also do one solo act if approved by director.
- 3. Acts must not exceed 1 minutes and 30 seconds and may be shortened at the director's discretion.
- 4. Costumes required for mandatory dress rehearsal.
- 5. If a student is using recorded music for an act, a digital copy of music, edited to the maximum time allowed, must be sent to the director by March 6th.
- 6. All vocal acts are recommended to use a Karaoke-style accompaniment track or live accompaniment. No lip-syncing please!
- 7. No inappropriate music, dance, costumes, or language will be permitted.
- 8. Participation in the talent show requires that all acts be present for the dress rehearsal and BOTH shows (morning school assembly and Friday evening performance). If a student is unable to attend the dress rehearsal, director must be notified and give permission for the missed rehearsal or student will not be allowed to perform.
- 9. 4th and 5th grade students (with priority to 5th graders) who wish to assist backstage or help emcee the shows must also submit a completed permission slip.

SILENT SHOWCASE RULES

- 1. **Completed permission forms** must be signed by a parent/guardian and returned to the school office by February 8th.
- 2. **Submissions must be turned in by Monday March 4**th in order to be assigned space to be shown. Parents will be sent a nameplate template to fill out and return with the submission. Label all submissions! All Tigers can take their work home with them the night of the show. If it is not taken, it might not get back to you. Keep copies!
- 3. No inappropriate images will be accepted.

BAKED GOODS RULES

- 1. Recipe cards must be turned in by March 4th a template will be emailed to all participants.
- 2. Baked goods must be brought in one hour prior to start time 5pm.
